Once the student has completed the three stages the student will take the Instrument Pilot Ground Final Exam on the last two days of the the course (see schedule).

The Final Exam (2 tests) will contain material from all three stages and must be passed with an average of 80%. The student will then be endorsed by a CFII to take the FAA Instrument Pilot Knowledge Exam and take the exam as their final class. *(Exam fee included in tuition fee and is non-refundable).*
